Paternoster Square is the latest outpost in French bakery chain Paul's British invasion (fair enough: it's not as though Paris isn't being overrun by *le sandwich* bars). The company now has 16 branches of varying size in Greater London, plus imminent openings on Piccadilly and in Holland Park.
